## REQUEST FOR HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIPS

Whereas, Daniel Patrick Maloney joined the Middletown Elks Lodge in 1983 and was elected Tiler in 1989 progressing through the Chairs as Esquire, Lecturing, Loyal and Leading Knights until becoming Exalted Ruler in the District and also took first place in Eleven o'clock Toast and the Flag Salute. Was appointed Hoop Shoot Chairman in 1988 through 1992 and Youth Activities Chairman from 1990 to 1992 and 1994 through 1998, and Ritual Chairman from 1994 through 1995 and again in 1996 through 2001 and was House Chairman in 1999 through 2000 and was Elk of the Year 2000 to 2001. In 2002 served again as Leading Knight and again was elected Exalted Ruler for the second time in 2003-04. Once again led Middletown as best Team in District Ritual and was named "All American Lodge".

Whereas, Daniel Patrick Maloney was instrumental in starting Lodge Carnival in 1992, which benefited the Handicapped Children's Committee for three successive years and Bingo the following year. Also served as Lodge Trustee for seven years and in 1995 along with Exalted Ruler Bob Negra negotiated a seven year fixed mortgage after years of a balloon mortgage. This mortgage was paid off in 2002. Dan has continually worked on other committees including Bingo, the House, Veterans, Hoop Shoot and Youth Activities.

Whereas, Daniel Patrick Maloney has been District Ritual Judge from 1994 to the present, District Youth Activities Chairman for six years, District Hoop Shoot Chairman for two year. Was elected to the office of Vice President in 2000 and served as Esquire to the District Deputy in 1994-95 and 2001-02.

Whereas, Daniel Patrick Maloney is currently Chairman of Auditing, Flag Day, Investigations and Hoop Shoot in the Lodge and also District Chairman of Auditing and is currently serving in his third year as Region I Chairman of Youth Activities.

Whereas, Daniel Patrick Maloney has always made the Community aware of the Middletown Elks for thier great work in the bayshore and throughout Elkdom, be it resolved that he be presented for Honory Life Membership.

Whereas, Robert Negra joined Middletown Elks Lodge in 1984 and was appointed to Inner Guard in 1989 and progressed through the Chairs as Chaplian, Esquire, Lecturing, Loyal and Leading Knight and was elected Exalted Ruler for the term 1995-96. He has been a committee chairman for Hoop Shoot, Auditing, Lodge Activities, Membership, National Foundation and Relief. As Exalted Ruler along with the Trustees solidified a seven year fixed mortgage, thus ending years of a mortgage with high percentage rates. This mortgage was paid off in 2002.

Whereas, Robert Negra served the South Central District as Lodge Activities and membership Chairman and was Secretary to the Vice President in 2000-01.

Whereas, Robert Negra has filled in as Chaplain on many occassions as Lodge District and State functions and has always exuded "Brotherly Love".

Whereas, as he has always been exemplary in his concern for the betterment of the Lodge over the past 23 years, be it then resolved that Robert Negra be proposed for Honorary Life Membership.






